SESAR 3 JU Prize for Young Scientist Award 2023

08 May 2023

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1 Introduction - What do I need to know?

1.1 What is SESAR?

The **Single European Sky Air Traffic Management Research and Development** (“SESAR”) project aims to modernise the air traffic management (ATM) in Europe and represents the technological pillar of the Single European Sky (SES). It aims to provide the European Union with a high performance air traffic control infrastructure, which will enable the safe and environmentally friendly development of air transport.

1.2 What is the SESAR Young Scientist Award?

The **SESAR Young Scientist Award 2023** (YSA 2023) aims to recognise young scientists with high potential contributing to the scientific research in the field of air traffic management and aviation. In addition, the award also provides a mechanism for further personal development.

The SESAR Young Scientist Award is a financial reward or “Prize” for the individual scientific achievements. It will be awarded following a public contest¹.

The SESAR Young Scientist Award 2023 is published and managed by the SESAR 3 Joint Undertaking (hereafter referred to as the “SJU”) and the result will be announced at its **SESAR Innovation Days** (SIDs) event, planned in Seville in November 2023², which is the main forum for dissemination of SESAR Innovative Research results and for interaction with the wider ATM research community and industry representatives.

NB: the present Contest is NOT a PhD or similar study funding programme³.

Applicants can apply to one of the following two categories:

- PhD
- Student

The (up to) three short-listed Applicants for each category will be invited to join the SESAR Innovation Days 2023, where the winner of each category will be publicly announced.

- The winner of the PhD category will receive a money prize of EUR 5000.
- The winner of the Student category will receive a money prize of EUR 1500.

The (up-to) three short-listed Applicants for each category will receive:

- a symbolic trophy,
- the opportunity to present their research at certain high profile SESAR events;
- the opportunity to have their work publicised via the SESAR 3 JU communication channels;
- a written interview and article spotlighting them and their research to be posted on the SESAR 3 JU e-news and social media;

2 Can I apply?

Any Young Scientist who has contributed to **scientific achievements within the area of Air Traffic Management and Aviation** as set forth below.

Within the **Student category**:

- Bachelor thesis defended⁴ not more than 18 months before the date of closure of the present Contest, or
- Master thesis defended not more than 18 months before the date of closure of the present Contest,

Within the **PhD category**:

- PhD thesis defended not more than 18 months before the date of closure of the present Contest,

and who are a citizen or a resident in an EU Member State or an Associated Country to the Horizon Europe Research and Development Framework Programme (HE).

Please note that non-thesis programmes are considered not eligible.

3 How do I apply?

3.1 Documents submission requirements

There is no fee to apply to the contest. Applications⁵ shall be submitted by email to youngscientist@sesarju.eu.

The **Application file** must contain the following:

1. Application Form including a description of the scientific achievements and the necessary references and details of the supervisor of the Bachelor, Master or PhD Thesis, the so-called "Tutor"⁶ (ref. Appendix A).
2. Declaration on honour duly filled-in and signed (ref. Appendix B).
3. Copy of diplomas/student certificates.
4. Legal entity form, dully filled-in and signed.⁷
5. Financial Identification form, dully filled-in and signed.⁸
6. Extracts of publications/papers, recommendations (if available) and the **Thesis** referenced in the Application Form⁹. Where such documents are publicly available online, it is sufficient to indicate the source in the application. In case of multi-author publications, the Applicant must clarify in the self-assessment of the Application Form

which part of the paper was contributed to by the Applicant.

3.2 How to fill in the application form?

In the table described under Appendix A, part 1B, Applicants must provide a self-assessment in the form of a descriptive text for the different award criteria listed.

The table under Appendix A, part 1C, must contain clear references to the source containing all the documents (e.g. articles, abstracts, presentations, etc) listed in the application, from which the Evaluation Panel can retrieve such information. Only supporting documents expressly and correctly referenced in the Application form will be considered by the Evaluation Panel for their evaluation of each criterion.

The Evaluation Panel will assess and mark the applications exactly as they were submitted. It may, however, issue requests for clarifications to the Applicants, which, if provided, may in no way modify or improve the initial application. The Evaluation Panel will not make any assumptions or interpretations in addition to what is in the Application.

Please note that emails sent to the youngscientist@sesarju.eu functional mailbox cannot exceed 10 MB.¹⁰

If available for the Applicants, the documents forming part of the Application file shall preferably be submitted in English. This would allow the faster evaluation of applications. Should any of the documents not be available in English, a courtesy translation would be appreciated, if possible.

The application email should be named as follows: **YSA2023 Surname Name – Application**.

Each enclosed document should be named as follows: **YSA2023_Surname_Name_Number of the attachment**.

Deadline for submission of applications is 8 September 2023, 24:00 CET. Applications submitted after this deadline will not be evaluated.

4 How will my application be evaluated?

The evaluation of applications will be carried out in three consecutive phases:

- I. **Administrative phase;**
- II. **Award phase;**
- III. **Post-award phase.**

4.1 Administrative phase

In the Administrative phase, the applications will be first evaluated on their admissibility:

- applications must be submitted in compliance with the deadline (see timetable section 1.3);
- applications must be submitted as set forth in section 3, sent electronically and include all the documents required;
- applications must be readable, accessible, printable.

Applications, considered inadmissible, will be rejected and not evaluated further.

Admissible applications will be evaluated strictly based on:

- A) exclusion,
- B) eligibility and
- C) selection criteria.

The application which does not fulfil the exclusion, eligibility and selection criteria will not be retained for the second stage of the evaluation under the Award criteria.

*With regard to exclusion criteria under point I.A.1 above, the Applicants will be assessed on the basis of their Declaration of Honour. The SESAR 3 JU may, however, at any time of the evaluation and before payment of the prize, request the original of the Declaration of Honour (Appendix B) and/or the documentary evidence (scanned or/and originals)¹⁴ on compliance on the exclusion criteria set out in the present contest rules.

4.2 Award phase

The SESAR 3 JU will convene an Evaluation Panel of high-level experts from the SESAR 3 JU and/or independent experts to perform the evaluation.¹⁵

The evaluation will be performed in accordance with the scoring tables reported hereafter.

For each category, the Evaluation Panel will provide the SESAR 3 JU Executive Director with a recommended and ranked list of the Applicants in its Young Scientist Award 2023 Evaluation Report, including their recommendation of the (up to) three short-listed Applicants.

Only applications having a score higher or equal to 70 shall be considered for the short-list for each category, in order to guarantee an adequate level of scientific excellence of the award.

On this basis, the SESAR 3 JU Executive Director shall then determine, for each category, the final ranked shortlist and the name of the winner of the SESAR Young Scientist Award 2023.

The short-listed Applicants will be invited to participate at the ceremony of the **SESAR Innovation Days**, where the final ranking will be publicly announced.

4.3 What happens if I win? – Post award phase

The winner(s) will be requested to submit **within 15 calendar days** following the announcement of the award the following documentation:

- **Evidence, supporting the Declaration of Honour, if requested so.**

Subject to their participation at the SESAR Innovation Days and the verification and acceptance by the SESAR 3 JU of the post award documentation (see above) the winner(s) will be invited to sign an **award letter**, accepting the prize award.

Within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of the signature of the award letter, the SESAR 3 JU shall make the payment to the selected Applicant bank account denominated in Euros, identified in through a duly filled in bank account form.

5 Processing of personal data

All personal data contained in the application shall be processed in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 2018/1725¹⁶ of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data.

The shortlisted Applicants will be invited to the SESAR Innovation days and to the award ceremony in November 2023.

6 Further conditions for participation

6.1 Publicity

6.1.1 Publicity by the winner(s)

The winner(s) should promote the prize.

Unless the SESAR 3 JU requests or agrees otherwise or unless it is impossible, any communication activity related to the Prize (including in electronic form, via social media, etc.) must:

- (a) display the EU emblem and the SESAR 3 JU special logo;
- (b) include the following text: “Co-funded by the European Union. Views and opinions expressed are however those of the author(s) only and do not necessarily reflect those of the European Union or the SESAR 3 Joint Undertaking. Neither the European Union nor the SESAR 3 Joint Undertaking can be held responsible for them.”

For the purposes of their obligations, the winner may use the EU emblem and the special logo without first obtaining approval from the EU and/or SESAR 3 JU. However, this does not give it the right to exclusive use. Moreover, they may not appropriate the EU emblem or any similar trademark or logo, either by registration or by any other means.

6.1.2 Publicity by the SESAR 3 JU

The SESAR 3 JU does not obtain ownership of the results produced in the context of the Prize.

The SESAR 3 JU may use, for its communication and publicising activities, information relating to the contest, documents notably summaries for publication as well as any other material, such as pictures or audio-visual material that it receives from the Applicants (including in electronic form).

The SESAR 3 JU will publish the name of both the shortlisted and the winner(s), their origin, the amount of the prize and its nature and purpose — unless they have requested to waive this publication (because disclosure risks threatening its security and safety or harm its commercial interest).

Photos and videos taken by the SESAR 3 JU either in preparation of the award ceremony or during the award ceremony are the sole property of the SESAR 3 JU.

6.2 Applicable law

The contest is governed by the applicable Union law complemented, where necessary, by the law of Belgium. The General Court or, on appeal, the Court of Justice of the European Union, shall have sole jurisdiction to hear any dispute between the SESAR 3 JU and any Applicant concerning the interpretation, application or validity of the rules of this contest, if such dispute cannot be settled amicably.

6.3 Checks, audits and investigations

The SESAR 3 JU, the European Commission, the European Anti-Fraud Office (OLAF), the European Public Prosecutor’s Office (EPPO) and the European Court of Auditors (ECA) may carry out checks,

audits and investigations in relation to the prize¹⁷.

6.4 Withdrawal of the prize — Recovery of undue amounts

The SESAR 3 JU may withdraw the prize after its award and recover all payments made, if it finds out that:

- a) false information, fraud or corruption was used to obtain it
- b) a winner was not eligible or should have been excluded
- c) a winner is in serious breach of its obligations under these Contest rules.

6.5 Administrative sanctions

If an Applicant has committed irregularities or fraud or has made false declarations, the SESAR 3 JU may also:

- a) exclude the Applicant from all future contracts, grants and contests financed from the EU or Euratom budget for a maximum of five years (or 10 years in case of repetition) and/or
- b) Impose a financial penalty between 2% and 10% of the value of the prize (or between 4% and 20% in case of repetition).

6.6 Liability

According to Article 206, Title IX, of Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046¹⁸, the Applicants shall have the sole liability in case of claims related to the activities carried out in the framework of the contest.

The SESAR 3 JU cannot be held liable for any damage caused to the Applicants or to third parties, because of the prize, including for gross negligence. The SESAR 3 JU cannot be held liable for any damage caused by any of the Applicants in the context of the prize.
