## INFORMATION TO THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIONS AND MISSIONS TO THE EUROPEAN UNION

Subject: Adaptation of the daily and monthly subsistence allowances for seconded national experts

Article 17(5) of Commission Decision C(2008) 6866 of 12.11.2008 laying down the rules on the secondment to the Commission of national experts and national experts in professional training specifies that the adjustment of the remuneration under Article 65 of the Staff Regulations shall apply automatically to the daily and monthly subsistence allowance in the month following this adjustment.

The adjustment having been set at 1,00%, the allowances foreseen under Article 17(1) of the Decision will be adapted **as from 1 January 2024** as follows:

- (1) Daily subsistence allowance: 161,63 €
- (2) Monthly subsistence allowance taking into account the distance between the place of origin and place of secondment:

The subsistence allowance paid to national experts seconded to another place of assignment than Belgium or Luxemburg will be adjusted with the new correction coefficients as from 1 January 2024.
