The aim of the Europe of Citizens Programme is to contribute to citizens' understanding of the history, values and diversity of the EU and to foster conditions for civic participation and engagement at EU level.



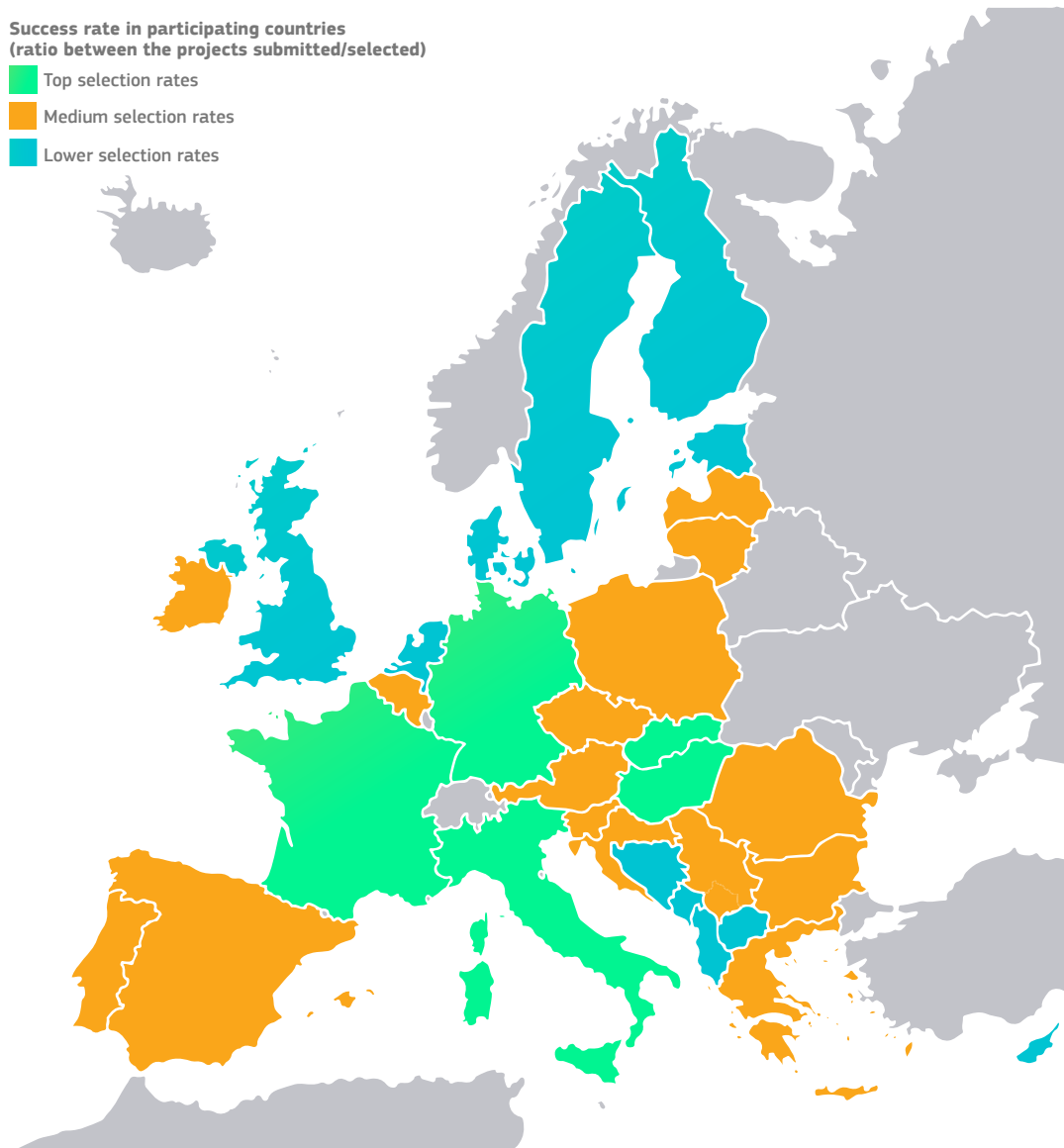
The Europe for Citizens programme raised awareness on remembrance, common history and Union's values and encouraged democratic and civic participation of European citizens. By addressing the programme multiannual priorities, the projects fostered intercultural dialogue and solidarity, promoted cultural heritage and diversity and reflected on European history, drawing lessons for today. Citizens were directly involved in debates and exchanges about the future of Europe and other themes of common interest, actively participating in the Union policy making process.

Europe for Citizens in 2014-2020



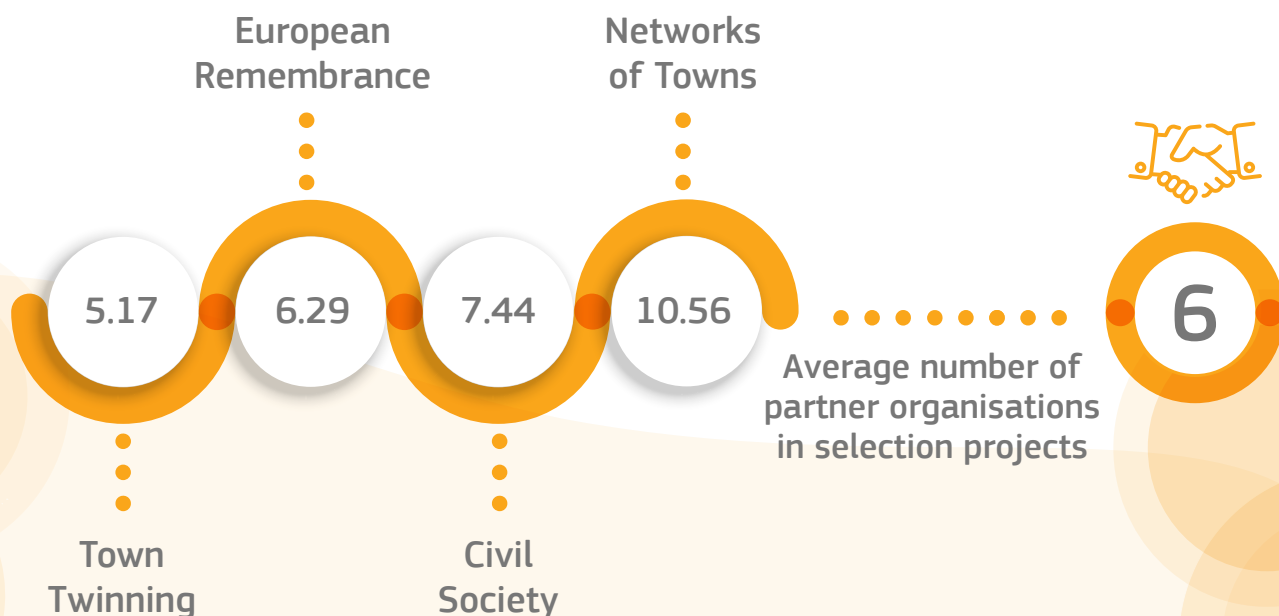
Success rate in participating countries

- Lower selection rates

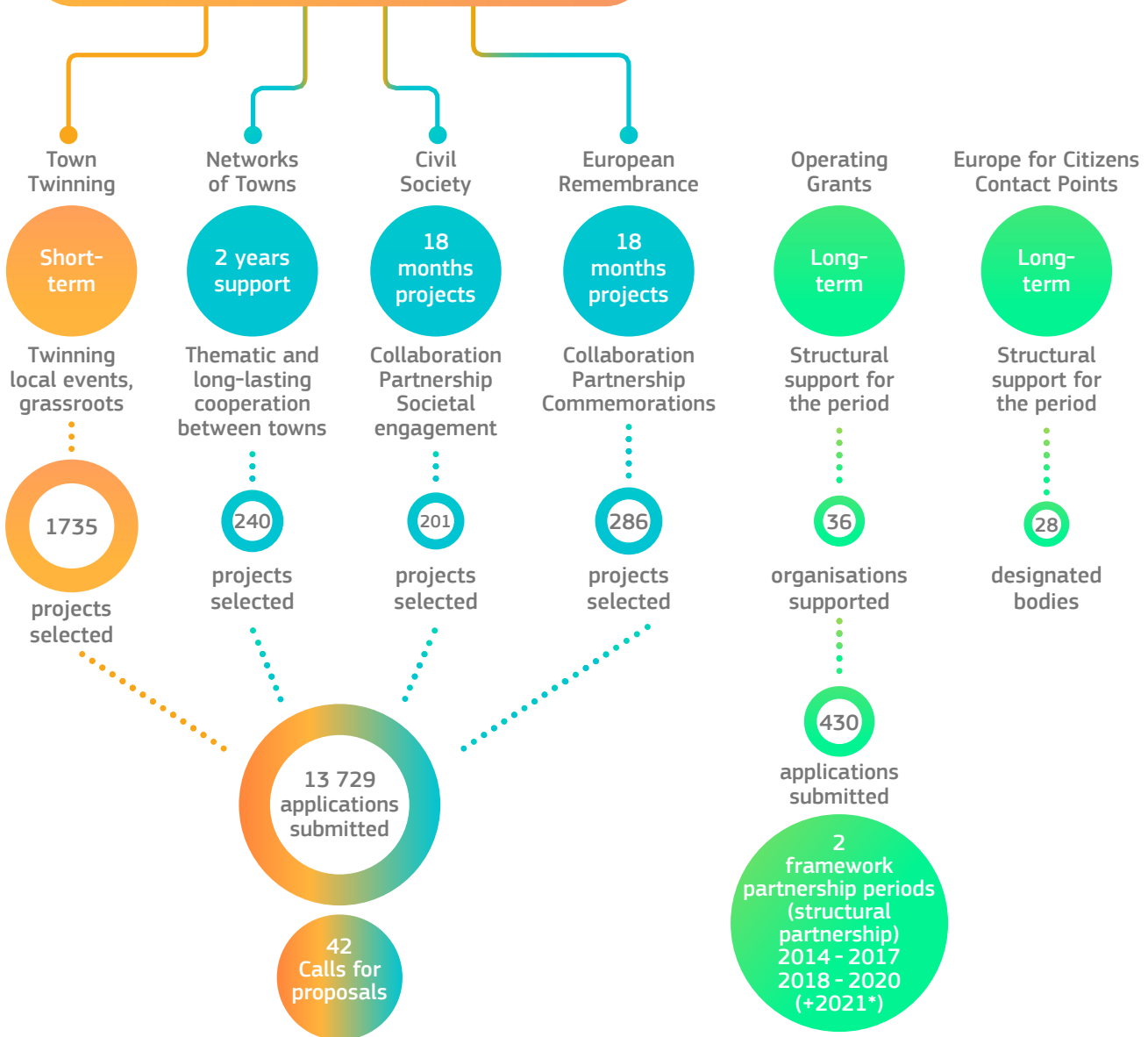


Partner organisations of selected projects are established in all participating countries (28 EU Member States + 6 Non-EU)

Countries with the highest number of selected projects (61 % in total) were Germany, France, Italy, Hungary, Poland, Romania and Slovakia

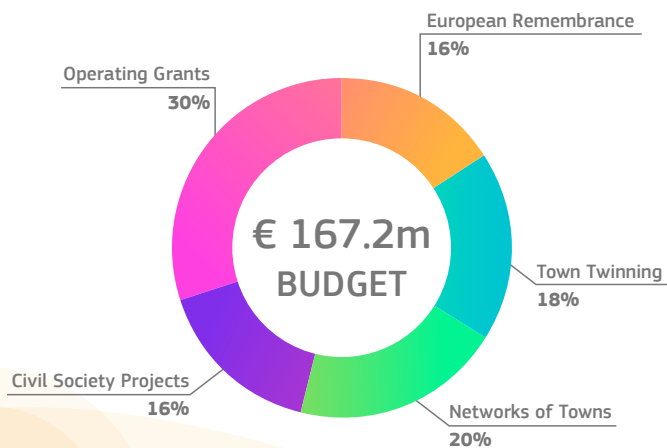


Action Grants in 2014 - 2020

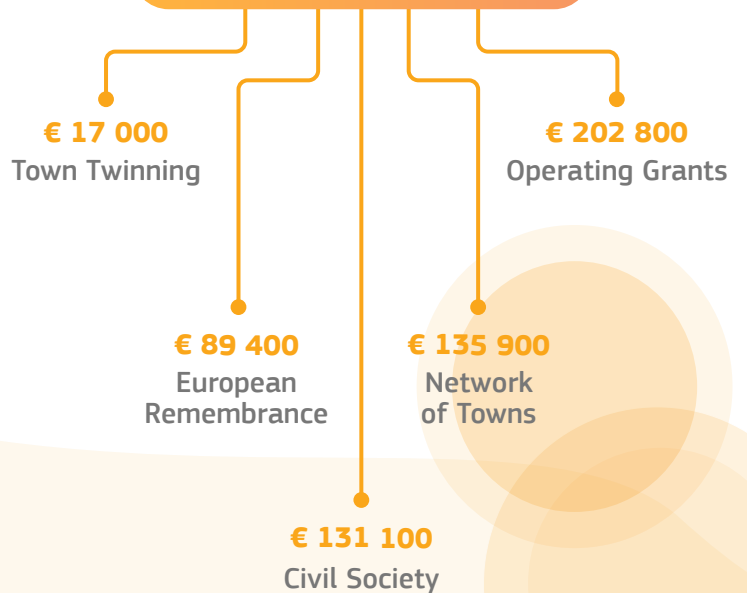

The new Citizens, Equality, Rights and Values (CERV) programme is available on the European Commission's Funding & Tender Opportunities Portal (F&TP).

Strengthening and promoting EU rights and values is a top priority of the European Commission.

The new CERV 2021-2027 programme reflects this priority, and with an overall budget of 1.55 billion euro for the next 7-year period, it represents the biggest-ever EU fund for promoting and protecting fundamental rights, rule of law and democracy inside the EU.
